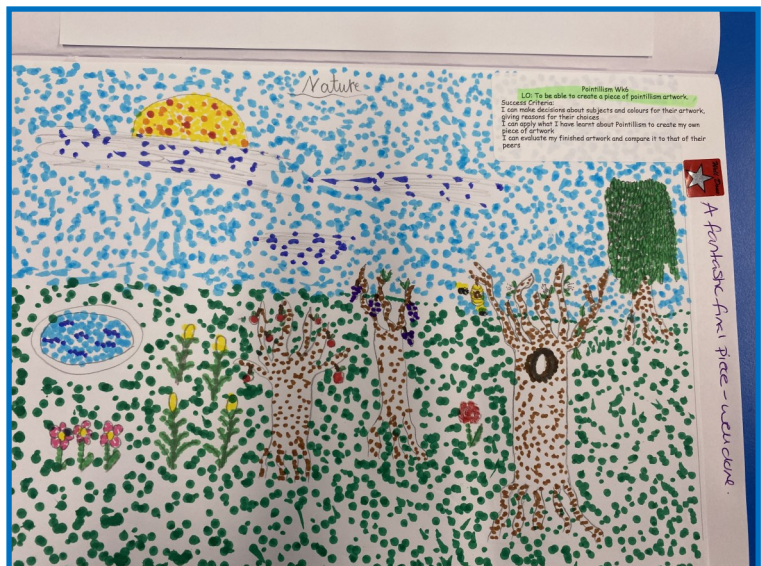
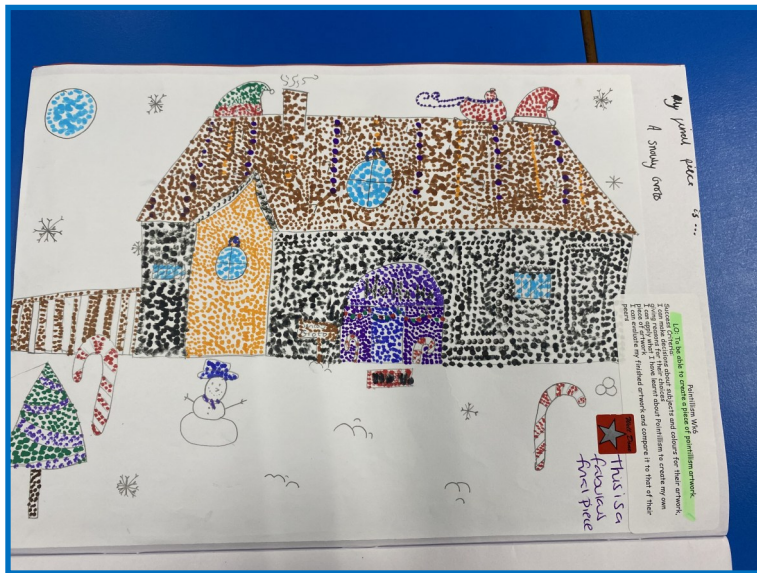
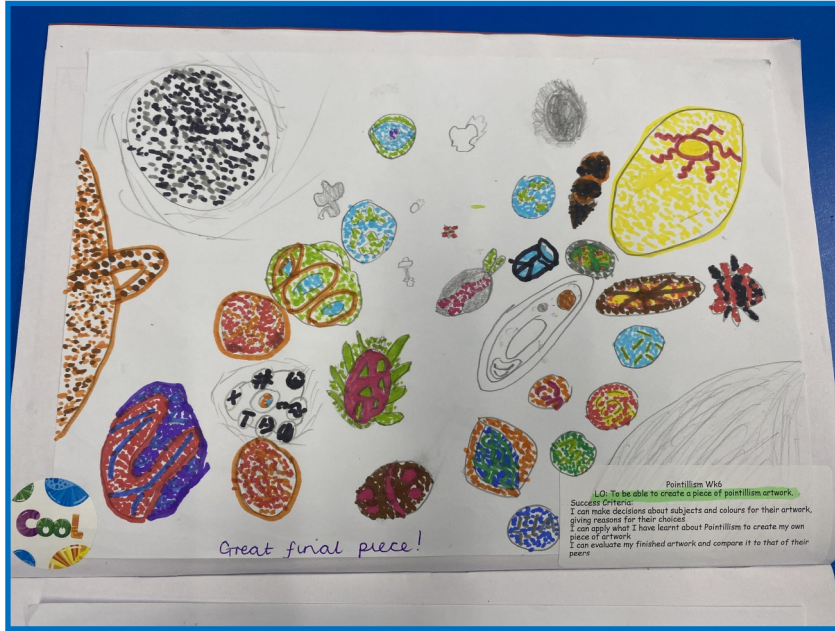


YEAR 4

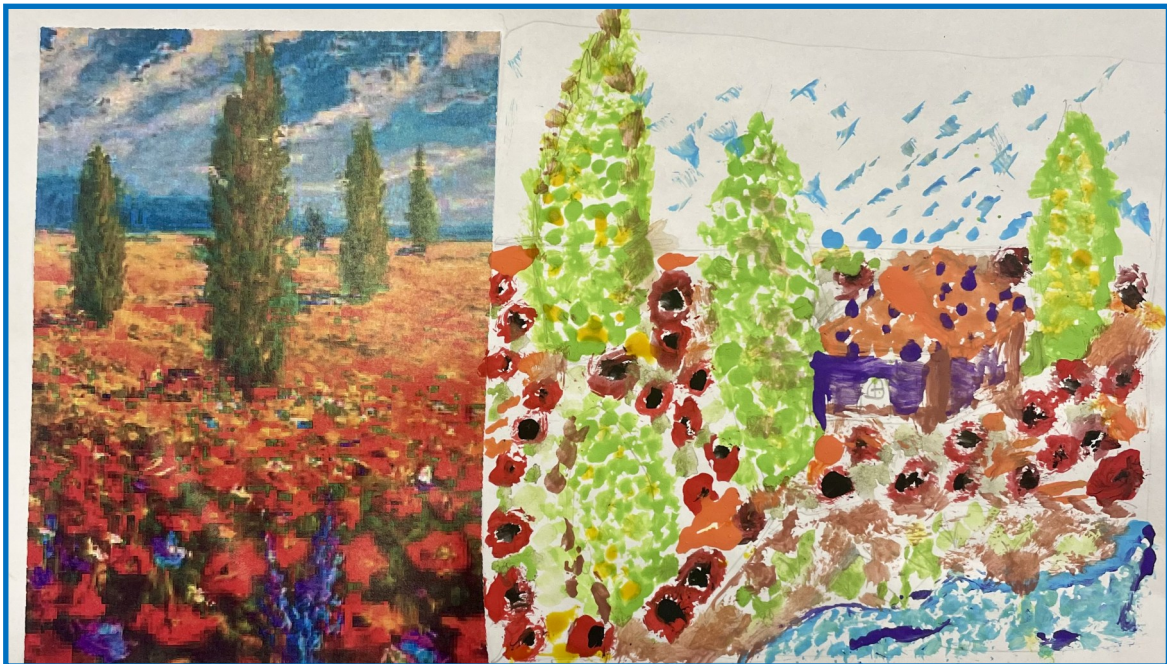

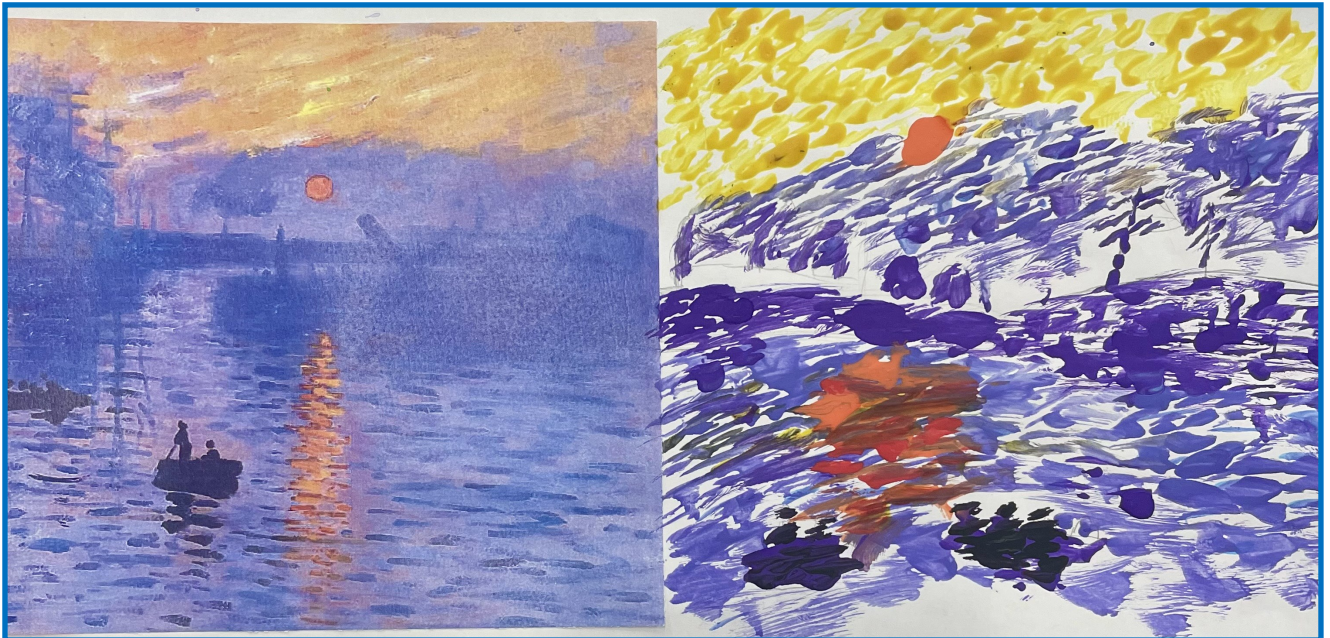

YEAR 6

Year 6 have been studying *Evolution and Inheritance* in their science lessons. As part of their learning, they carried out an investigation inspired by Charles Darwin's theory of evolution and his famous study of finches on the Galápagos Islands.

To explore how different beak shapes are adapted for different types of food, the children used a variety of tools to represent finches' beaks and tested them on a range of "foods" such as seeds, berries and insects. They discovered that animals are adapted over time to suit their environments — and that these adaptations can lead to evolution.

Year 6 thoroughly enjoyed this hands-on activity!

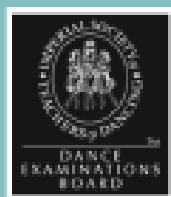

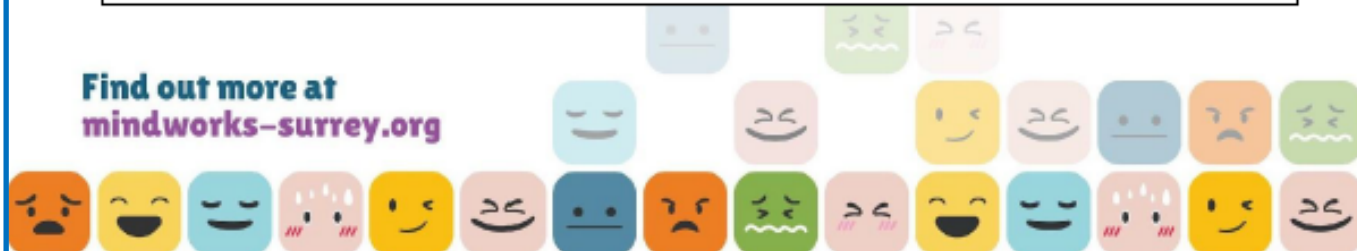

WHAT TO EXPECT – WEEKLY SESSION DETAILS:

1. Terrific Time Machines

Children kick off the term by designing and building their own 3D time machine, using colourful card, foam shapes, and fun embellishments. They also plan what they'd pack for their adventure through the ages.

2. Loopy Greek Labyrinths

After hearing the myth of Theseus and the Minotaur, children craft a swirling maze with string and card. They then try writing their name using the Greek alphabet!

3. Medieval Illuminated Initials

Children explore medieval manuscripts and decorate their initials on foil with colourful patterns, flowers, vines and mythical creatures, just like scribes of old.

4. Fantastic Fossils

Children draw fossil patterns and create their own clay fossils using shells and dinosaur shapes — then paint and display them just like real paleontologists!

5. Fantastic Future Homes

In this imaginative finale, children design their dream home of the future. Flying beds? Solar domes? Floating gardens? Anything is possible in the year 3000!
